

WOUNDED ANIMAL POLICY

We are in the business to manage and propagate the big game herds on our private concessions to the best interest(s) of all our clients. To keep and promote the quality hunts we offer, a policy is necessary in regard to the wounding of animals.

This is our policy:

A client hunting, with any type of weapon, wounds an animal, his/her hunt for this particular specie (Elk, Deer, Bear or Antelope) will cease. We will then proceed to make every effort possible to track down and render to possession this particular wounded specie, even if it takes the duration of the hunt. If we feel this animal is mortally wounded and are unable to track it down, then we would have to end this hunt for this particular specie. On any hunt (bow, rifle, or muzzleloader) **the minimal harvest fee will apply to any animal/specie wounded that we are unable to retrieve.** If you have a tag in possession for any other specie, (Elk, Deer, Bear or Antelope), you may continue your hunt for that specie only.

The wounded fee will be due and payable (\$1,000 or the minimum fee due) before the end of your hunt. If the wound is deemed by the guide to be non-mortal, then your hunt may continue. However, if there is a second wound, then the regular harvest fee schedule will apply.
